Check out the options below to see which one best fits your needs.



## Payment Options

### Automatic Payments

This program allows you to automatically pay your quarterly bill through your checking or savings account. This service is free to you and is the easiest, most dependable, and most convenient way to pay your water & sewer bill. To sign up for this program, click on **ACH Billing & Paperless Billing Form** and print the application. Complete it by hand, being sure to date and sign it, then mail or deliver it to City Hall. Be sure to include a voided check. The ACH payment will apply to your next quarterly.

### In-Person Payments

Residents & businesses can pay their City of Rochester water & sewer bill in person by cash, check, money order, credit or debit card at City Hall, 400 Sixth Street, Rochester, MI 48307.

Please note, a convenience fee will be added for any credit card and debit card payments.



### Online Payments

Rochester water & sewer bills can be paid online using a checking account, credit or debit card, with a convenience fee added.
